THE ARIZONA MASONRY COUNCIL TENDER TRAINING PROGRAM

Certifying participants in scaffold erection & dismantle, heavy equipment awareness, rigging, OSHA 10, First/CPR, stocking, mixing, shop drawing interpretation, and much more.

*Classes are held on Saturdays from 7AM to 10AM from Jan through May.

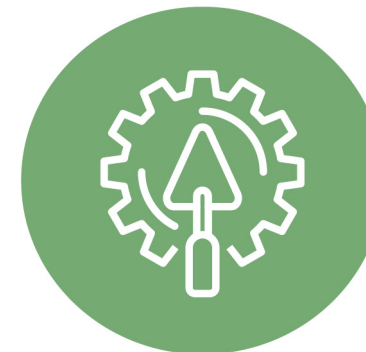

The Arizona Masonry Council (AMC) Central and Southern AZ Masonry Apprenticeship Programs are registered with the US Department of Labor, Office of Apprenticeship and the Arizona Department of Economic Security, Office of Apprenticeship. The AMC's Masonry Apprenticeship Program is a three year "earn-while-you-learn" program that combines on-the-job learning, classroom instruction and hands-on skill development. Applicants will be invited to attend an Apprenticeship Program Interview Night which will be held in late October or early November. Program acceptance letters will be sent out in late November or early December.

Classes are held on Saturday mornings from 5AM to 11AM from Jan through Nov.

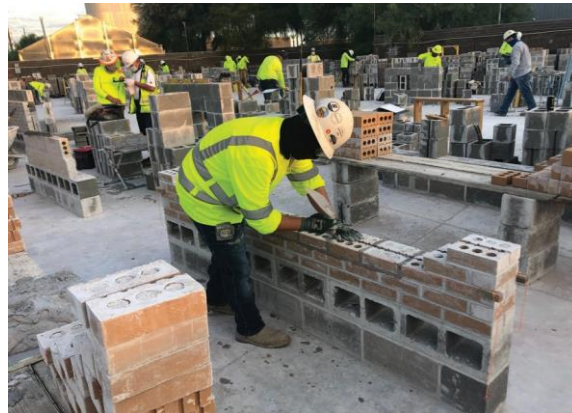

THE ARIZONA MASONRY COUNCIL MACHINE OPERATORS' PROGRAMS

The AMC's Masonry Machine Operators Program is a three year "earn-while-you-learn" program that combines on-the-job learning, classroom instruction and hands-on skill development. Objectives include basic hydraulic, pneumatic, mechanical, electrical, and electrical control systems. Along with concrete masonry technology training. Applicants will be invited to attend an Apprenticeship Program Interview Night which will be held in late October or early November. Program acceptance letters will be sent out in late November or early December.

Classes are scheduled Jan to November. Classes are held at various producer facilities and Mesa Community College.
